SPACE INFORMATION: Food Truck Vendor fee is \$500.00 per Food Truck. Event hours are 4:00p.m. – 9:30p.m. Tuesday, July 4th, 2017. **Set up begins at 12:00p.m. Tuesday, July 4th, CONTACT Tricia Yamashita to schedule an earlier time if needed. Drive onto the soccer field and park your vehicle. Walk to the Food Vendor Tent and check-in with the Coordinator to receive your assigned FIELD location for the Food Truck & parking pass for (1) extra vehicle. Upon receiving your assigned FIELD space you may move your FOOD TRUCK to your assigned space. FOOD TRUCKS will not be allowed to leave soccer field before the end of the event. NO EXCEPTIONS.** Area must be broken down and clean by 11:59p.m. on July 4th.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:

Booth assignments are at the complete discretion of Kaua'i Hospice, Inc (herein KH).

Each Applicant/Food Truck Vendor space will be allowed FREE entrance for 8 individuals (this includes the applicant) to the Event. The applicant will be given 8 wristbands for FREE entrance at July 4th event upon check-in at the Food Vendor Booth tent during set-up on July 4th from 12:00pm– 3:00pm. All Food Truck vendors MUST provide menu signage and pricing.

We encourage a variety of menu pricing options. This is a family event and we value keeping pricing affordable for families of all sizes.

A Kaua'i Hospice Representative will contact you within three (3) business days of receiving your complete application and payment to confirm your space at the Event. Receipt of payment by Kaua'i Hospice, does not confirm space. **Applications and all fees must be received and paid by June 30.** Failure to pay in full and submit all required information by June 30 will exclude the Applicant from the event. Applicant fees are non-refundable except for those vendors whose applications are not accepted. **A copy of a valid Hawaii State Business License & Food Permit must be submitted with your application and fees.**

IMPORTANT: Registrant vehicles will not be allowed into the park Event area after 3:00pm on Tuesday, July 4, 2017. Kaua'i Hospice, its officers, agents and sponsors are not responsible for any product or property left overnight. Registrant must remain open during the entirety of event hours. No early break downs. Registrants and their agents are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner, abide by the rules of the festival and exhibit the spirit of aloha. The Kaua'i Hospice, 4th of July Concert in the Sky is a Drug, Tobacco and Alcohol-Free event. Consumption of illegal drugs, alcohol or tobacco at the event is strictly prohibited. All food vendors must provide a copy of their certification from the State Department of Health to KH and display it at their booths. KH, its directors, or agents has the right to determine what goods or services may be sold by a Registrant, without liability to its directors, agents or sponsors. KH, its directors, or agents has the right to exclude a Registrant from participation in the Event, for any reason, without liability to its directors, agents or sponsors. Registrant in consideration of participation in the 4th of July Concert in the Sky sponsored by KH, individually, jointly and in any representative or legal capacity, on behalf of Registrant, Registrant's heirs, executors, and/or administrators, does hereby waive, release, discharge and agree to hold harmless and indemnify Kaua'i Hospice, Inc., its officers, agents and sponsors from liability or loss of any claim for death, injury, or damage to property resulting directly or indirectly from the Registrants participation in the Event.
